

This mountain, now teeming with life, was steeped in blood during the First World War.

But harmony returned to the region, and in time, the traces of the Isonzo Front were strung together into the cross-border Walk of Peace from the Alps to the Adriatic, and Sabotin, today shared between Slovenia and Italy, became a park of peace on this path.

A tour of its sights and curiosities presents and upholds both cultural and natural heritage, which, in their contrasts, testify to the absurdity of war and invite reflection on the precious value of peace.

Sabotin's position at the crossroads between the Mediterranean, Dinaric and Alpine regions has endowed the mountain with remarkably varied plant and wildlife. Along with extraordinary views extending from the sea to the highest Slovenian peak - Triglav -, Sabotin provides endless recreational opportunities in every season.
